From Pastor Mark's desk:

Apologies for The Chimes being late – I am certain that we can blame it on me. In any case, here is something that I promised to share with you all.

One of the things that your Congregation Council is responsible for is to be responsible for casting the vision for how we live out the Great Commission of our Lord Jesus in Matthew 28. In the last several months, your Council has been working to better understand why we do things the way we do them, so that we can have a better idea of how to move forward in doing our Lord's work in this place. You have been a part of that process. If you recall the recent survey that was looking at our Core Values, your Council used that information at a coaching session with Pr. Kerrigan from our Synod Office to help guide our work.

In tabulating your responses, we found that the top four values of our congregation are Worship, Community, Prayer, and Preaching and Teaching. We talked for a bit about what all this means, and how it works in our faith life here at St. John's. The Council, in our follow up session put together statements of what this means for us, and asked me to share this with you in an article.

We approached the values through the lens of our Vision Statement – We are learning, living, growing, with Christ as our Leader, and this is what we came up with:

1. Worship

Worship is the place where the community is supposed to all come together, and it is the place where we most easily experience following the cross of Christ into the world. This is the place where we grow.

2. Community

Community is our family of faith – this is where we live in the world. Like all families, this is the place where we find love and support, even in the midst of our disagreements and hurts, because we are in this together.

3. Prayer

Prayer is our connection to our leader Jesus. Prayer is the opportunity we have to share all of our hopes, dreams, and concerns with our Father.

4. Preaching and Teaching

Preaching and Teaching are where we learn all of the good things that our Lord has done and is doing for us. This is the place where we see the vision of God at work through us in the world.

Our hope is that this will help to better guide us in understanding why we approach things in the church, based on what matters to us in the background. We also hope this helps us move forward in proclaiming the Gospel in the world using the gifts and talents we have been given. Look for this coming to you in other ways in the future so that we can keep learning about how to continue to grow in this place where God has planted us. Until next time.

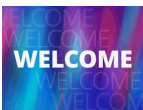
